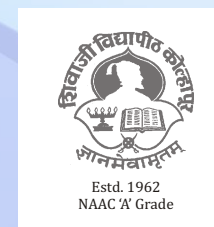

### **Shivaji University:**

Shivaji University, established in 1962, is named after Chhatrapati Shivaji, with the major objective to cater to the educational needs of Southern Maharashtra. The jurisdiction of the University is spread over three districts viz. Kolhapur, Sangli and Satara. The University, presently has a strength of about 3,00,000 students studying in 290 affiliated Colleges, recognized institutes and 40 Departments which offer conventional and non-conventional Graduate and Post-graduate courses. **Late Smt. Sharadabai Govindrao Pawar Adhyasan:** Late Smt. Sharadabai Govindrao Pawar Adhyasan was established in September 2013 at Shivaji University, Kolhapur under the auspices of donation of Rs. 50 Lakhs by Pawar Trust. The major objective of the Adhyasan is to disseminate and cultivate values like equality, justice, rights and given. It also aims towards encouragement of research on the subjects like women empowerment, social, economic, political issues of women. To realize these objectives the Adhyasan has been actively organizing seminars, workshops, guest lectures and several extension and research activities.

### **Concept note of the Seminar:**

We are celebrating twenty fifth anniversary of the historic 73<sup>rd</sup> and 74<sup>th</sup> amendments to the Constitution of India. Opening a Gateway for women in Local self governments through 33% reservations, these amendments heralded a new era in the Indian democracy. Many states have gone ahead and introduced 50 percent reservations for women in all local bodies. Entry of women in local self government has raised many issues. During last 25 years women have tried to prove themselves as leaders, but with many hurdles. Rotation of wards, proxy candidature, extension of patriarchy from domestic sphere to public sphere, lack of exposure etc. have posed challenge to women leadership. Of course there are success stories as well.

73<sup>rd</sup> and 74<sup>th</sup> Amendments paved the way for women empowerment throughout India, but in every state & region the nature of women empowerment varies due to different socio-cultural settings. Hence there is a need to understand how women leadership is making dent in different states.

Yet another issue relevant in this context is the women reservation awaited in Lok Sabha and Vidhan Sabha. One needs to probe this issue, as to why the efforts in this direction are becoming futile.

Late Smt. Sharadabai Govindrao Pawar Adhyasan takes an opportunity to review the successes and failures of 73<sup>rd</sup> and 74<sup>th</sup>

amendments especially with reference to empowerment of women on the occasion of 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of these amendments.
