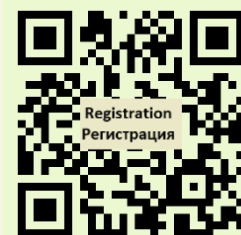

- **Full paper** of not more than 3000 words (as per guidelines given below) is to be submitted by September 15, 2021.

Guidelines for preparing papers

- 1) The article should be presented as independent research. The acceptable level of originality (anti-plagiarism) is at least 75%
- 2) Recommended content structure of the main text of the article: introduction (problem statement), research methods, results and their interpretation, conclusions
- 3) The text of the submitted articles must be typed in the MS WORD editor (text file format- .docx or .doc)
- 4) The article should contain the following data (separated by a line space):
 - The title (in capital letters, in the centre)
 - Name and surname of the author/authors (right justified)
 - Country (alignment to the right)
 - Abstracts (not more than 500-700 printed characters or not more than 200 words) and keywords (5-6 words) in Russian/English. Abstract and Keywords (Index Term) must be in Font Size 12, Bold, Italic with Single Line Spacing
 - References must be in Font Size 12, Hanging 0.25 with single line spacing
 - The list of references should include all works cited or mentioned in the text of the article. The sources should be drawn up in accordance with the Harvard style (see <https://www.mendeley.com/guides/harvard-citation-guide>)
 - Links to sources are formatted in the text as follows - [3, p. 18]; [4, p. 22; 4, pp. 19–21]
- 5) Paper Setup must be in A4 size with Margin: Top 2cm, Bottom 2cm, Left 2cm, Right 2cm
 - Whole paper must be with: Font Name Times New Roman, Font Size 14, Line Spacing 1,5
- 6) Articles that do not meet the specified requirements are not accepted for publication.
