All the participants are requested to apply and register their names for the Workshop and send their Patent Writing Proposal Letters on or before Monday, July 11, 2018 to Anil Ghule, Member Secretary/Director IPRC.

#### **The objectives of the Workshop:**

1. To create awareness on the importance of Intellectual Property Rights (especially patent rights).
2. To embrace Innovation and Intellectual Property Rights driven ecosystem amongst stakeholders and industry.
3. To sensitise the participants on how to draft patents in various subject matter.
4. To provide a platform to interact with key patent attorneys in their respective specialized fields.
5. To create awareness amongst larger mass of faculty and research scholars attracting and encourage them to draft patents by themselves and thereby extending help to others in this in future.
6. To provide an opportunity to generate Intellectual Property from the research work of participants prior to going for publication of their research work.
7. To help Shivaji University to improve its global ranking in this regard.
