Dr. Vilas Sangave joined the Department, as Reader and Head in the year 1975. He became Professor and Head in the year 1979. Dr. R. B. Patil Dr. S. M. Dahiwale and Dr. J. B. Ambekar (Yadav) joined the Department in the year 1979, and 1983 respectively. Dr. S. N. Pawar took charge of the Department initially as a reader and Head 1980 and later on as a Professor and Head 1983. Mr. D. Shrikant joined the Department as a lecturer in the year 1987. Dr. S. A. Salunkhe joined the Department in the year 1991. Dr. R. N. Salve Joined the Department as a Professor in the year 2003 and Mr. B. N. Kendre is also joined as a lecture in the same year. Former Professor and Head of this Department Prof. (Dr.) J. B. Ambekar joined as UGC Emeritus Professor in 2008.

About the Workshop:

6. Enhance skills to conceptualize and writing research proposals, prepare an appropriate research design, including conducting an overview of literature,

formulating research questions and hypotheses, collection of information and analysis;

7. Develop the capacity for developing e content, writing a research paper for publication; planning and writing a book;

How to Apply -

Interested candidates can apply to **Course Director** along with duly filled up registration form on or before **28th Feb 2019**. Registration Fee: There is no registration fee.

Selection Criteria:

Only 30 seats are available for the course. Registered Ph.D. students of any recognized Indian university/research institute in any branch of Social Sciences would be invited for this training workshop. The candidates with basic knowledge of statistics and computer application and belonging to a participant belong to SC/ST/OBC and Minority communities from nearby states, e.g. Karnataka, Goa, Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh specifically from Rural background will be preferred. Participants must bring personal laptop

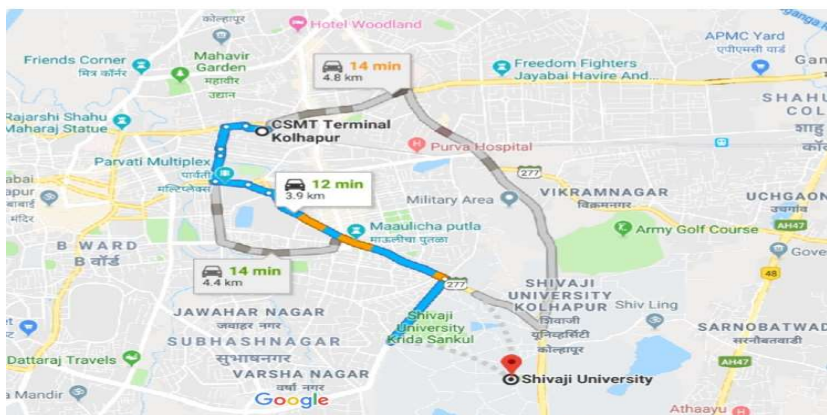
Accommodation and Travel Allowance: Accommodation will be provided to all the outstation participants and will be accommodated in the University Guest House. Travel allowance by shortest distance (bus or train fare, sleeper class only) will be reimbursed to the outstation participants.

How to Reach:

Rail: Kolhapur has a railway station and it's an 11-hour journey from Mumbai or Bangalore to Kolhapur.

Road: Kolhapur is about 450-km south of Mumbai and it's a ten to eleven hour journey from Mumbai or Bangalore to Kolhapur by road. Maharashtra State Transport Corporation (MSTC) has regular service on this route with semi luxury and regular buses. Even the private bus service is available to reach here from Mumbai, Pune, Goa, Solapur (also spelt as Sholapur) and Bangalore.
