**For Research Scholar and Teachers belong to SC/
 ST/OBC/Minorities**

About the Workshop:

The course on 'Capacity Building Programme in Social Sciences' is designed to impart knowledge for scientific research to integrate qualitative and quantitative approaches in research and orient the young researchers to new advance techniques for precise, rational and scientific research. It also aims to train the scholars with advance statistical packages including SPSS for using in various fields and sub fields of social sciences. It is particularly meant for those who are engaged in survey research and have some basic knowledge of data processing, analysis and interpretation. One of the purposes of the training programme is to help scholars with some of the basic features of computerized database management and the use of computers in data analysis and data interpretation. The course would include a combination of theoretical lectures and practical experience on computers and some commonly available computer applications for both quantitative and qualitative analysis of data. The participants would be given some research project and the data generated would be used for application of various statistical concepts and techniques, from simple univariate to more complex multivariate techniques of data analysis. Both Excel and SPSS would be used for data processing and analysis.

Methodology of the Workshop:

The course will be operated through theoretical lectures and practical application of different research modules and statistical

techniques. The participants would be provided some generated data and computers for application of discussed research methodology. Group participation, field survey as well as research paper writing techniques would be also operated in this program.

Objectives of the Workshop:

1. Develop capacity for conceptualizing and writing research proposals;
2. Enhance skills to prepare an appropriate research design.
3. Enhance capacity for writing a research paper and a book for publication

How to Apply:

Interested candidates can apply to **Course Director** along with duly filled up registration form on or before **25th January, 2018..** The candidates are required to send the form duly forwarded by the head of the department to the email ID: **avinash.bhale@gmail.com**, followed by hardcopy of the application. Registration forms can also be downloaded from the university website **www.unishivaji.ac.in**

The duly filled registration form must be accompanied with the following enclosures: (1) Brief CV of the applicant (2) Ph.D. registration/supportive documents (3) Caste Certificate (4) Ph.D. synopsis along with the research progress. (Minimum 500 words)

Registration Fee: There is no registration fee.

Selection Criteria:

Only 30 seats are available for the course. Registered Ph.D. students of any recognized Indian university/research institute in any branch of Social Sciences would be invited for this training workshop. The candidates with basic knowledge of statistics and computer application and belonging to a Participant belong to SC/ST/OBC and Minorities communities from nearby states e.g. Karnataka, Goa, Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh specifically from Rural background will be preferred. Participants must bring personal laptop

Accommodation and Travel Allowance: Accommodation will be provided to all the outstation participants and will be accommodated in the University Guest House. Travel allowance by shortest distance (bus or train fare, sleeper class only) will be reimbursed to the outstation participants.

How to Reach:

Rail: Kolhapur has a railway station and it's an 11-hour journey from Mumbai or Bangalore to Kolhapur.

Road: Kolhapur is about 450-km south of Mumbai and it's a ten to eleven hour journey from Mumbai or Bangalore to Kolhapur by road. Maharashtra State Transport Corporation (MSTC) has regular service in this route with semi luxury and regular buses. Even private bus service is available to reach here from Mumbai, Pune, Goa, Solapur (also spelt as Sholapur) and Bangalore.

Local Transport: Auto-rickshaws are the most common mode of transport along with the bus service run by the municipal corporation. Taxis are also available
