SUK pupils to monitor noise levels in city today

Kolhapur: A team of students from the department of environmental sciences of Shivaji University Kolhapur (SUK) will monitor the noise levels on the last day of Ganesh festival here.

"There are three noise-measuring devices available with us. A team of five-six students will be visiting different parts of the city in different sessions to get an idea of noise levels," P D Raut, head of the department, said on Monday.

It may be noted that readings during the previous few years by students of the same department had shown that almost all areas they had monitored during the day and at night crossed

the permissible sound levels set by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB).

Areas like Udyamnagar, Rajarampuri, Shahupuri, Laxmipuri and Mahadwar road consistently showed above 90 decibels during the

day as well as at night in the past celebrations.

A official of the department said, "On the fixed timings, a 10-minute reading is taken. Four such readings are taken in 60-minute intervals in a particular area and the readings are calculated accordingly."

A city-based environmental activist said that the overall spirit of Ganesh festival over the years has changed drastically.

"Earlier, it used to be very peaceful and harmonious. However, the festival has become totally political and is losing its purpose. The use of loudspeakers not only creates environmental pollution, but it is also harmful for the health," the activist added.

Varsity students to get training in sericulture

Kolhapur: The department of zoology from Shivaji University, Kolhapur (SUK) will receive hands-on training on the sericulture technology from September 11 at Mysuru in Karnataka.

Experts from Central Research and Training Institute in Mysuru will guide the students throughout the whole process.

A D Jadhav, professor at the department of zoology, SUK, told TOI, "The training is important for students. They get to know about the advancements in sericulture. The students' entrepreneurial skills are also given a push. These students can start their own sericulture farming or they can advise their friends and families about the advantages of it."

Jadhav said that the department always gives a push to students' entrepreneur skills and sericulture is one such department which is still relatively unexplored.

Elaborating on the course he added that students will be trained for five days from September 11. It will focus mainly on the basics of sericulture such as mulberry varieties and their characteristics, silk-worm breeds and their incubation as well as boxing and silk-worm rearing.

He added that as many as 24 students and two progressive farmers from Satara are being sent to the said training program.

He further said that the training program has been organised in the past two years. Students and farmers who have be-

en there, are actively working in this field.

"Farmers, who have attended the sessions there, have witnessed a rise of almost 40% in their production later on. We will be soon signing an MOU with the Mysuru University, to facilitate periodic lecture and workshops on sericulture in future," added Jadhav.

According to Jadhav, the sericulture department of the state government purchases cocoons as per the prescribed rates and quality from farmers. It provides them with insecticide to get a good silk harvest.

The state government has also started various schemes to promote sericulture among farmers, wherein they can turn into independent entrepreneurs, according to Jadhav.
