Syllabus for the Common entrance test: The syllabus for the common entrance test will include 50 multiple choice questions based on current affairs, aptitude, attitude test and media happenings. The minimum marks to qualify the CET will be as per the rules of Shivaji University. The merit list based on the marks obtained in the CET will be displayed on the university website/department notice board.

### **Master of Journalism**

Candidate should appear for and qualify in the Common Entrance Test, which will consist of 100 marks. The test will be based on four multiple-Choice 50 questions on media happenings, general knowledge, and aptitude. To pass the test, candidates must achieve a minimum of 40 marks. The Common Entrance Test can be taken in either online or offline mode. The merit list, based on the marks obtained in the Common Entrance Test (CET), will be displayed on both the University website and the department notice board.
