22. **Statements:**

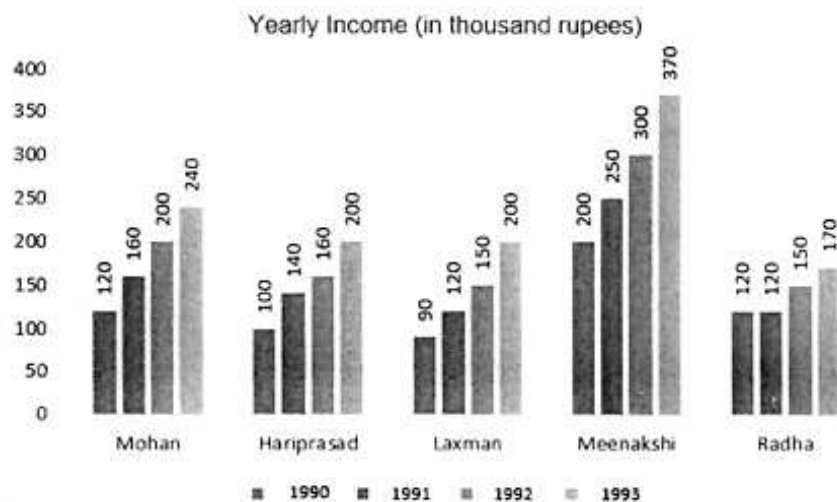
- (1) All players are aggressive.

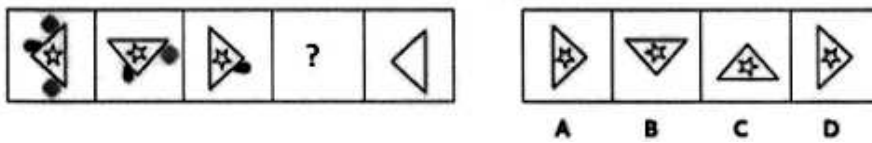
