They are one of the leading suffering communities in Maharashtra as well as in India., Scientifically known as a Hijarah is someone possessing both male and female characteristics and behaviour.

The 'Eunuch' i.e. Hijarah Community or Trans Gender person are deprived of several rights because Indian Law recognizes only two sexes. This people are not able to vote, own a 'Rashan Card' which is the casic immunity for the survival provided by the Government. They are in minority under minorities. They are deprived of the Four Pillars i.e. [life, liberty, equality, dignity] of constitution as well as The Protection of

GO on equality for transgenders

Chennai, March 6: In a significant move that will bring a change in the lives of the transgenders in Tamil Nadu, a Government Order has been issued to ensure equal opportunity to them in society.

The Government Order on 'Rehabilitation of Aravanis' (Eunuchs) was recently passed by the Social Department Welfare based on the re-commendations of a sub-committee, comprising government officials from the Social Welfare, Health and Education departments along with social workers.

The order states that the Social Welfare Department will seriously look into legalising Sex Re-Construction (SRC) surgery in Government Hospitals for the transgenders. At present, the surgery is not legal in the state, forcing many transgenders to undergo the surgery in other states. The order says the Social Welfare and Health departments will soon come out with a separate plan to legalise the surgery.

in coordination with re-cognised and qualified counsellors (Health and Social Defence Departments) will also provide counselling for Men Having Sex with Men (MSM) and transgenders regarding the surgery. The de-partment will identify MSMs at an early stage to prevent complications.

In an important move, the order has further stated that government offices should not discriminate against the tra-

nsgenders.

'Serious action will be taken against those who ill treat or misbehave with the transgenders,"

said sources. Instead, transgenders will be given priority in all government offices and hospitals on a humanitarian basis. "Government doctors should provide proper treatment and counselling to them without discrimination," sources explained.

The government will take serious disciplinary action against schools and colleges that deny admission for transgenders based on their sexuality.

The Health Department The School and Higher Education departments will soon issue necessary circulars to this effect.

To guide the transgenders on the right path, schools are expected to provide counselling to children with behavioural changes and teachers will be trained for this, said the order.

Family counselling by teachers and NGOs will be made mandatory in all areas to ensure that such children are not disowned by the family. The Education Department will be involved for this

purpose.

For providing liveli-hood for transgenders, special vocational training and skill development training will be given to a considerable number of them in a phased manner. The number of selfhelp groups, already in place for them, will be increased.

Besides these, the government will soon take up the assessment and survey of the transgenders in the state.

The order says District Collectors take up the survey through revenue officials. For a better understanding of issues concerning the transgenders, a research on their behaviour and lifestyle will be taken up.

The District Collector will be the key person re-sponsible for implementation of the orders. The circulars have already been sent to them and they will have to coordinate with all the officials and police personnel.

Further, the Collectors will conduct special grievance meetings regularly It is also planned to sensitise officials on the treatment of transgenders.

"Hijarah" or "Eunuch", are the people who are known as third sex people. They are neither categorized in the gender of male nor female. They are one of the leading suffering communities in Maharashtra as well as in India., Scientifically known as a Hijarah is someone possessing both male and female characteristics and behaviour.

The 'Eunuch' i.e. Hijarah Community or Trans Gender person are deprived of several rights because Indian Law recognizes only two sexes. This people are not able to vote, own a 'Rashan Card' which is the basic immunity for the survival provided by the Government. They are in minority under minorities. They are deprived of the Four Pillars I.e. [life, liberty, equality, dignity] of constitution as well as The Protection of

Human Rights Act, 1993. They are deprived of getting education as no university or school is giving admission in the gender of the third person. If they are going to remain illiterate than the ultimate option which remains for them is to beg and earn money which the general citizen do not like. Not providing with this kind of provision government is throwing them to die.

We hereby pray to the Hon ble commission to take a serious cognizance in the matter as soon as possible.
