Sub: Creating awareness about unnecessary honking and road safety.

Greetings from the Transport Commissioner Office!

Vehicular honking in cities has reached alarming levels, contributing 70% of the noise pollution in our environment. Honking is a menace that is plaguing our city and affecting all of us, including children. Normal acceptable ambient sound levels for human habitation are not above 55db. Honking creates sounds of 110 decibels and above. Most of Mumbai for most of the time registers over 70db of ambient noise, much above safe for human habitation levels.

Exposure to such noise for long periods leads to gradual hearing loss, decrease in concentration on academics and stress in students. High levels of sound from honking causes aggression and irritation, depression, hypertension, stress, memory loss and panic attacks.

Honking is avoidable, as most of the drivers try to release their frustration and tension by blowing horns, possibly due to lack of awareness about the damage their mindless honking is doing to us.

In addition to the above, it is observed that there are more than 1.5 lakh deaths by road accidents in the country every year, and Maharashtra accounts for about 15000 deaths. The Department is concerned about this level road accident and is determined to reduce the same by taking appropriate measures.

Transport Department (Motor Vehicles Department) has initiated a campaign against honking and for road safety. We feel, that participation of students in the drive against honking and creating awareness about road safety will go a long way in controlling the same. Hence in this regards, we appeal to them to join the campaign and create awareness in the society.

Details of the campaign: Walk-a-thons to be organized at 50+ locations across Maharashtra supporting the above causes – at the same time on the same day, creating a unique record. The officers and staff of this Department will be positioned near traffic signals or suitable places near schools/colleges/hospitals/courts, where students can actively come and conduct the campaign along with officers. Students can be encouraged to create posters/ placards / slogans / banners which can be displayed at these spots.
