Dear Sir/Madam,

University Grants Commission is running a scheme entitled "Colleges with Potential of Excellence" to strengthen Under-graduate and Post-Graduate teaching programmes, to encourage excellence in research in colleges and engage in outreach activities. All universities are requested to invite proposals from affiliated colleges covered u/s 2(f) and 12B of the UGC Act (except agriculture/medical/dental/nursing and pharmacy colleges) as per the prescribed proforma available in the guidelines for Colleges with Potential of Excellence. The guidelines are available on the website of UGC [www.ugc.ac.in](http://www.ugc.ac.in) and must be perused for details. The proposals so obtained by the affiliating university must be scrutinized by a Committee consisting of the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar/Dean, College Development Council and two/three experts from outside the University to authenticate the data provided by the applicant college and also score the data under specific parameters as per the scoring scale available in the guidelines. Self-financing colleges can also apply but will not be eligible for grants under the scheme.


Maximum of 08 colleges are eligible to be recommended by your esteemed university on order of merit on the basis of the scores obtained by them.

The proposals of these recommended colleges must reach the office of UGC latest by **15<sup>th</sup> February, 2015**.


