

CERTIFICATE COURSE IN PORTUGUESE

Revised Syllabus (Semester Pattern)

General Information:

The *Certificate Course in Portuguese (A1 - Basic User I)* is a course of **ONE-year** duration with **TWO SEMESTERS** with the examination conducted at the end of every semester. Teaching hours: 180.

This **Course** is compatible the CEF (Common European Framework of reference levels for languages: learning, teaching, assessment) and it is scaled at the broad **level A1 Basic User I (Breakthrough)**.

Eligibility:

The candidates who have passed H.S.C. (12th Std.) or an equivalent examination **OR** who have completed a Three-year Diploma Course after 10th Std. are eligible for admission to the Certificate Course in Portuguese.

Aims & Objectives:

1. **To introduce learners to the basic structures and sounds of European Portuguese**, enabling them to understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very simple phrases aimed at satisfying immediate needs (e.g., greetings, introductions, numbers, and asking basic questions).
2. **To develop essential communication skills** in listening, speaking, reading, and writing, allowing learners to interact in a simple way when the other person speaks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.
3. **To build a foundational vocabulary and cultural awareness**, focusing on common topics such as family, food, shopping, time, and daily routines, while also offering an introduction to Portuguese-speaking cultures and customs.

Examination:

The evaluation of *Certificate Course in Portuguese* shall consist of two components:

- A. Internal Assessment based on UNIT TEST. **Marks 10**
- B. The **Semester Examination** at the Certificate Course in Portuguese will consist of two components:
 - a/ **one WRITTEN paper** of TWO hours duration with **40 marks** and,
 - b/ **one ORAL examination** of **25 marks**.**Total marks – 75.**

Standard of Passing:

To pass the Certificate Course Examination in Portuguese a candidate has to obtain at least 40 % in written and oral examinations **separately**, and also a minimum of 40% in the Internal Assessment.

1 st Class with distinction	75% or more in the aggregate of the written and oral examinations.
1 st Class	60% or more but less than 75% in the aggregate of the written and oral examinations.
2 nd Class	50% or more but less than 60% in the aggregate of the written and oral examinations.
Pass Class	40% or more but less than 50% in the aggregate of the written and oral examinations.

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
