

1. PREAMBLE

Pali, the liturgical language of Theravada Buddhism, holds immense significance as it preserves some of the earliest Buddhist scriptures and teachings. This program is designed to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of Pali, fostering an appreciation for its linguistic, cultural, and philosophical heritage.

Our Certificate Courses aim to equip students with the skills necessary to read, comprehend, and interpret Pali texts. By delving into the rich literary and philosophical traditions embedded in Pali literature, students will gain insights into the historical context and teachings of early Buddhism. This program caters to scholars, researchers, and enthusiasts who seek to deepen their knowledge of Buddhism and its foundational texts.

9. CONVERSION TABLE: SGPA & CGPA
