Course Outcomes (COs)

Course I: Introduction to Museology and Museum Management

This course is of introductory nature. The students will understand the concept of the museum and learn the basic principles of museology. They will be exposed to the basic principles of museum management and administration.

Course II: Collection, Documentation and Public Education

This course introduces the students to the technical knowledge needed in the field of museology. It deals with collection, documentation, and display of museum objects. Moreover, the students will also learn the legal aspects of object acquisition. They will understand the basic principles of organizing an exhibition or display.

Course III: Care and Preservation of Museum Objects

In this course, the students will gain comprehensive knowledge of the process of caring and conserving museum objects they will be introduced to the technical knowledge needed to preserve and conserve museum objects.

Course IV: Case Study and Dissertation

This course gives the students an opportunity to apply their knowledge of museology in a practical situation. The students are expected to undertake projects and case studies related to the functioning of the museum.

The course will test the practical applicability of the theoretical principles of museology. The students will gain hands-on experience of data collection, analysis, evaluation and report writing. This paper includes case studies/field visits undertaken by student during the course. Students can visit any two Museums for Case Study and prepare a detail written case study report for submission.
