- A Google Drive link of film should be submitted on email id-journalism@unishivaji.ac.in till 4 May 2023, 5:00 pm.
- The participants must also carry a copy of their submitted film along while attending the festival.
- The participants may submit a colour poster (A-4 Size) of their submitted documentary film for publishing purpose.

- . Only students (Sr. College & University) can participate in the festival.
- The festival is open to any film within the mentioned themes.
- Only the producer or director of the documentary can send the entry to 'Rajarshi Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaja National Documentary Film Festival 2023'.
- Total time duration of the documentary must be less than 5 minutes in length, including beginning and end credits.
- The documentary film can be in any language. All films must have English subtitles.
- . A director or producer may submit one or more number of documentaries.
- The selection of the documentary for screening and awards will exclusively be the jury decision. Jury decision will be final.
- All the winning documentaries will receive Shivaji University emblem and certificate. There will be no entry fees for the participation in the documentary film festival.
- The festival does not cover any of the expenses of travelling and accommodation of the participants.
- All the participants who have registered for the festival will receive the participation certificate on the day of the event.
- Participants must submit their documentary as per bellow mentioned criteria only.

Legal Implications ▶ Documentary films that are submitted must be the entrants' original work and shall not infringe on any copyrights or any other rights of any third parties. An undertaking for which should be duly signed by the producer / director only (attached with the registration form).
