#### 1) From the Desk of the Head:



Shivaji University's P. G. Department of Law is providing a platform to the students who are keen to get knowledge about law and want to opt law teaching and research work in Law as their carrier. It aspires to mould its students through a combination of exposure to the advanced syllabus with IPR and Business Law as specialization with employability and capacity building training, clinical legal education programmes and curricular

and extra-curricular activities. Its central library is rich with online and offline resource providing for legal studies through its knowledge resource centre. It has also enthusiastically committed to excel in a smooth adhering to the online teaching mode to accept the challenge thrown up by the Covid-19 pendamic situation. Emphasis is given on activities such as National Moot Court Competitions, Legal Aid Camps, visits to various Social Institutions. The Department of Law emphasises upon research based learning at the Masters level. It imparts training to the students on field research work with the help of statistical analysis with the significant results. The Department of Law is dedicated to the cause of rule of law and promotion of excellence in the realm of legal education in India.

## 2) Brief History of the department along with present focus in academic & research:



The P. G. Department of Law was established in the year 2000. The Department was situated at Humanities Building since its establishment until it got shifted to a new building near Barr. Balasheb Khardekar Knowledge Resource Centre in the year 2011-12. The Department runs four Law Programmes such as LL.M. for Two Years, Ph.D. in

Law, Post Graduate Diploma in Human Rights and Values in Education (PGDHR) and Post Graduate Certificate Course in Alternative Disputes Resolution. (PGCADR). Adv. Santosh A. Shah was the first coordinator of the Department till 2003. Thereafter Dr. R. B. K. Nayak was appointed as the Head of the Department (from 2003 to 2015). Presently the Department is headed by Dr. Vivek Yeshwant Dhupdale (w.e.f. 02—05-2015 till date). There have been 4 Assistant Professors (Temporary) appointed for 11 months for the last 5 years.

Initially, the intake capacity for LL.M. course was only 20. Thereafter, since 2005 onwards the intake capacity got increased to 60 for LL.M. - I as well as LL.M. – II course. The PGDHR and PGCADR were introduced in the year 2015-16 with intake capacity as 80 and 50 respectively. So far we have 20 Ph.D. in Law declared for the last 5 years. Presently 20 students have been enrolled for the Ph.D. course. Three Ph.D. in Law students were awarded with Scholarship from the funding agency such as BARTI, Pune and Shivaji University's Golden Jubilee Scholarship.

The P. G. Department of Law has conducted three International workshops by inviting three foreign experts like Prof. Marc David Brown, Washington State University's School of Law, USA, John Van Doren Jack, Professor Emeritus, Florida State University' School of Law, USA and Dr. Jean Pierre Mian, Law Attorney, Geneva Switzerland.

Every year the P. G. Department of Law organizes All India Shivaji University Moot Court Competitions in order to provide its students a wide range of exposure to legal practice and interaction with the students from various Universities and Law Colleges all over India. It has also organized various National and International Seminars, Conferences and Symposiums online as well as offline.


