
INSTITUTIONAL VALUES AND BEST PRACTICES

1. Teaching and Learning


In order to instill the research aptitude in the students, we implement N^3 mechanism, that is, Nucleate, Nurture and Navigate. During first four years of the program, students are given the Mini projects, which help them in inculcating and nurturing of the fundamental skills required to be a good researcher.

During this activity, students learn to do a literature survey, to write scientific articles, and to find a research problem for their Master's project. This practice has resulted in making our students capable of publishing research papers in peer viewed International journals and the proportion of the students getting admitted for their Ph.D. in the foreign countries have increased exponentially.



2. Administration

Procuring circulars, purchases and bills are important part of efficient functioning of the School. To address the bottlenecks the School formulates Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for all the sections. Under this SOP's the functioning of the School has become smooth and the office staff has become more efficient.



3. Courses on Human Values

In any academic institute along with quality education and research its very essential to focus on developing human values in the students. If a student with good academic credentials also possesses Friendliness, Sense of responsibility
