The Department of Sociology was established in 1970-71 and both M.A. in Sociology and Ph. D. courses were started in the department. M.Phil. course was started in 1986. The number of students has obtained post-graduate and research degrees from the department and they are placed in different universities and government organizations in India. The Department faculty members are actively engaged in organizing national and international level seminars, workshops and conferences and also

carried out several research projects funded by UGC, ICSSR, and Government of Maharashtra. The UGC, in 1994, had recognized this department as a resource center in the field of teaching and research and as a result of it, department had introduced a paper on Sociology of Environment at M.A. level, organized four national seminars; organized XXIII All India Sociological Conference (23-25, November, 1996) with the main theme: “Ecology, Society and Culture”; organized one refresher course on the theme: Sociology of Environment. With due recognition of earlier achievements of the department, this department has been identified by the UGC under SAP-DRS-Phase- I program with the thrust area as Sociology of Development and Environment in 2004-05 and it has successfully completed UGC/SAP/DRS-Phase- III in the academic year 2019-20, focusing the major thrust areas such as Environment and Society, Poverty and Social Inequality, Gender and Society and Sociology of Mass Communication and Information Society. In the fifty years journey of the department, Dr. M. M. Awate, Prof. Vilas Sangave, Prof. S. N. Pawar, Prof. R. B. Patil, Prof. J. B. Ambekar, Prof. Sarjerao Salunkhe, Prof. R. N. Salve and Prof. Jagan Karade lead the sound academic foundation of the department and contributed to its academic achievements. The department is also blessed with the guidance of eminent Sociologists such as Prof. J. V. Ferreira, Prof. S. P. Punalekar, Prof. B. S. Baviskar, Prof. D. N. Dhanagare, Prof. Uttamrao Bhoite, Prof. Sudha Kaldate, Prof. Binod Agarwal, Prof. Harish Doshi etc.

Brief History



The Department of Sociology was established in the Shivaji University during the academic year 1970-71 with Dr. M. M. Awate as the In-Charge Head of Department. Subsequently, Mr. B. B. Deshmukh and Dr. S. N. Pawar joined the Department in the year 1971. Mr. B. B. Deshmukh left the Department in the year 1972. Miss. Usha Tribhuvan was with the department for a period of five years from 1972 to 1977. Dr. Vilas A. Sangave joined the Department as a Reader and Head in the year 1975. He became Professor and Head in the year 1979. Dr. R. B. Patil, Dr. S. M. Dahiwalé and Dr. J. B. Ambekar (Yadav) joined the Department in the years 1979 and 1983 respectively. Dr. S. N. Pawar took charge of the Department initially as Reader and Head (1980) and later on as a Professor and Head (1983). Mr. D. Shrikant joined the Department as a lecturer in the year 1987. Dr. S. A. Salunkhe joined the Department in the year 1991. Prof. R. N. Salve and Dr. B. N. Kendre joined the department in the year 2003. Dr. Pratibha Desai has joined the Department in 2008 and Dr. Pralhad Mane in 2011 as an Assistant Professor. Dr. Jagan Karade joined the Department in 2013 and Dr. Pratima Pawar in 2014 as an Associate Professor. Prof.

R. B. Patil and Prof. R. N. Salve retired in 2016 and Prof. Jagan Karade has taken charge as a Head of the Department in May 2016 and remained as Head of the Department till February 2023. In February 2023, Prof. Pratima Pawar has taken charge as a Head of the Department.
