

**Subject: Schedule of Selection Trails for Selection of Indian University Judo (Men & Women) on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 at CSJM University, Kanpur (Formerly- Kanpur University, Kanpur); for the forthcoming World University Games 2021 at Chengdu (China); with COVID-19 Protocol issued by the MYAS, Govt. of India.**

**Dear Sir/Madam,**

Greetings from CSJM University, Kanpur (Formerly- Kanpur University, Kanpur)

The 31<sup>st</sup> World University Games 2021 is scheduled to be held at Chengdu (China) from 18<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Association of Indian Universities New Delhi has entrusted the responsibility of conducting the selection trials of Indian Universities Judo (Men & Women) teams at CSJM University, Kanpur (Formerly- Kanpur University, Kanpur).

In this connection, I now on behalf of CSJM University, Kanpur extend a warm and heartily welcome to all the participants and you are requested to send the eligible Men and Women Judo players of your university to participate in the selection trials of Indian University Judo (Men & Women) teams on scheduled **12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2021** at Multipurpose Hall, CSJM University Campus, Kanpur (UP).

The players who will attending the selection trials should produce the following documents at the time of selection trails:

1. Eligibility proforma duly signed by the University Authorities (Two copies), duly typed and signed by the authority of the university as per AIU Rules. Incomplete proforma will not be entertained. No over-writing is permitted on the proforma unless attested by the competent authority of their university.
2. Identity Card of the Current Session.
3. Valid Indian Passport (Original & Xerox Copy).
4. Four passport size photographs.

All the players/participants must follow the protocol of the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India (copy attached ). The following documents/protocol are mandatory to participate under the Covid-19 SOP:

- (a) All the players must submit a **NEGATIVE** Report on Covid-19 RT-PCR Test issued 72 ours prior to the Trials and it must be sent to the Email: [kusport1@gmail.com](mailto:kusport1@gmail.com)
- (b) The above RT-PCR Test must be done at any of the ICMR approved Laboratories
- (c) **MUST** be wear a MASK to cover face at all times with minimum two lair and should not the valve type mask.
- (d) All the participants must frequently do hand wash with soap ( at least 40-60 seconds ) wherever feasible.
- (e) Self-monitoring of health by all the participants and must report to the Technical Officials in case of any illness.
- (f) Spitting in the field of play, arena are strictly prohibited
- (g) All the participants must installed the Aarogya Setu App, and must be updated.
- (h) All participants must submit the Self-Declaration on Covid-19 during the Registration.

The confirmation of participation must be received in Office on or before 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 through their respective Universities. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ENTERTAINED AFTER THE DEADLINE i.e. 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2021.** Entries must be Send to Email: [kanpuruniversitysports@gmail.com](mailto:kanpuruniversitysports@gmail.com).

The FISU General Regulations for participation (Annexure - I) & Sports Specific Eligibility (Annexure - II) criteria prescribed by the organizing committee for participating in the selection trails is attached here, along with SOP guidelines from Govt. of India and weight categories mentioned in FISU regulations for the WUG- 2021. Further, registration Fee of Rs. 1000/- per athlete and during the selection trails, the lodging and boarding facilities will be provided at University campus by depositing Rs. 500/- per day/per person. The selected players have to attend coaching camp and the information of the same will be conveyed to the respective universities in due course of time.

#### CONTEST RULES:

The bouts will be played on the basis of the JFI/JF Contest Rules and Regulations and the Sporting code and any amendments made there to, by the JFI/JF from time to time.

#### FEMINITY CONTROL:

A medical certificate in English/Hindi issued by a qualified Gynecologist of the players State/Deptt. attesting the Sex & Non pregnancy of the women players must be submitted on demand.

#### DISQUALIFICATION:

- Any player who by word, action or deed disrupts and or/interrupts the smooth and normal conduct of the Trails on or off the mat, will be liable for immediate disqualification.
- Any player/official who do not follow the Covid-19 protocol as per the SOP of MYAS will be disqualified with immediate effect.

The decision of the Selection Committee will be treated as final.

Team Incharge should report with all above documents at Office of the Secretary Sports Board, CSJM University Campus, Kanpur one day before trail.

The Selection Trials will be held for the following 07 Men & 07 Women weight Categories only:

**Men:** up to 60 kg, + 60 kg to 66 kg, + 66 kg to 73 kg, + 73 kg to 81 kg, + 81 kg to 90 kg, + 90 kg to 100 kg, + 100 kg.

**Women:** up to 48 kg, + 48 kg to 52 kg, + 52 kg to 57 kg, + 57 kg to 63 kg, + 63 kg to 70 kg, + 70 kg to 78 kg, + 78 kg.

Annexure-I

**GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION OF INDIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY  
TEAMS/ATHLETES**

**FISU GENERAL REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION**

**I. General Eligibility**

1. The athletes:
  - A. be a national of the country they represent;
  - B. born between 1 January 1996 and 31 December 2003;
  - C. students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the university or similar institute, the status of which is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country;
  - D. Former students of the institutions mentioned in c) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the calendar year preceding the event.\*

**II. General Guidelines for Selection of Indian Universities National Team/Athlete**

- 2.1. Merit will be based on Individual score and not the team score for individual events.
- 2.2. The decision of the selection committee will be final and binding.
- 2.3. Participation in WUG 2021: The other expenditure i.e. travel expenses, registration fee, incidental charges, playing kit, ceremonial dress, local transport, visa fee, accommodation charges, participation fee etc., will be borne by the concerned universities.

\*Due to Covid-19 Pandemic

#### **2.4. Selection Trials:**

- A. Registration Fee: of Rs.1000 per athlete.
- B. Boarding and Lodging: For boarding and lodging Rs. 500/- per head-per day from athletes & officials (concerned University) may be charged by the host/organizing university.
- C. By taking into consideration the prevailing pandemic situation and involvement elite sports persons in Olympics or other recognized international tournaments/national camp/trials etc, the Selection Committee with prior information shared to AIU may consider absentia to an athlete on the basis of his credential at international level. To avail of this exemption, the athlete will submit their application with documentary proof to AIU duly endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor of the concerned university.
- D. After the selection trial, a national camp may be allocated by AIU to a member University and the information of the same will be conveyed to the respective universities by host/organizing University in due course of time.

#### **2.5. Camp:**

- A. During the above said coaching camp the expenditure of boarding and lodging about Rs. 500/- per head-per day from athletes & officials (concerned university) and other expenditure i.e. travel expenses to and fro, camp venue sports specific consumable equipments, if any will be borne by the concerned universities.
- B. The national camp if conducted is compulsory for all selected players. The Selection Committee decision in consultation with AIU will be final in this regard.
- C. By taking into consideration the prevailing pandemic situation and involvement elite sports persons in Olympics or other recognized international tournaments/national camp/trials etc, the Selection Committee may consider absentia to an athlete on the basis of his credential at international level, with prior information shared to AIU. To avail of this exemption, the athlete will submit his/her application with documentary proof to AIU duly endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor of the concerned university.

## **JUDO**

### **Sports Specific Eligibility of Players/Teams for participation in Selection Trails of the Indian Universities Judo Team (Men & Women)**

1. Top 8 (eight) athletes (in each category as mentioned in FISU Regulations for the WUG-2021) of the 1<sup>st</sup> Khelo India University Games 2020.

Or

2. Players who were top 8 (eight) in Senior or Junior National Championship of last 3 (three) years (from 1st July 2017 onward).

Or

3. Top 8 Players in Khelo India Youth Games-2020/School Games may be considered for trails.

Or

4. An International player who has represented India in Senior or Junior categories of last 3 (three) years (from 1st July 2017 onward).

Or

5. Players who have extraordinary international sports credentials or top scores / results at Indian national trials of concerned sports but not covered under above mentioned categories, may also apply for the selection trials to AIU. After duly scrutinizing their performance by the expert committee of AIU, the eligible players will be informed accordingly.

6. It may please be noted that the players of above-mentioned categories for selection trials is to be recommended by the Director Sports/Head of the Sports Department/DSW of concerned Universities.

7. Merit will be based on Individual score and not the team score.

8. The decision of the Selection Committee will be final and binding.
