Sub : Schedule of Selection Trials of Indian University Shooting (M&W) Teams for World University Games 2021 at Chengdu (China).

Respected Sir/Madam,

Greetings from Manav Rachna

The 31st World University Games 2021 is scheduled to be held at Chengdu (China) from 18th- 29th August 2021. Association of Indian Universities (AIU) has entrusted Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies, with the responsibility of conducting the selection trials of Indian Universities Shooting Teams.

In this connection, you are requested to send the entries of eligible Shooters (Men/ Women) of your university to participate in the selection trials scheduled from February 26 to 28, 2021 at Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies Campus, Faridabad.

The players attending the selection trials should produce the following documents at the time of selection trials:

1. Eligibility proforma duly signed by the University Authorities (Two copies).
2. Identity Card of the Current Academic Session.
3. Valid Indian Passport (Original & Copy)
4. Four passport size photographs

The trials will be conducted in the following events:

Rifle Discipline:

- a. 10m Air Rifle (60 shots) (Men/Women)
- b. 50m Rifle 3 Positions (3 x 40 shots) (Men/Women)
- c. Mixed Team

Pistol Discipline:

- a. 10m Air Pistol (60 shots) (Men/Women)
- b. 25m Rapid Fire Pistol (60 shots) (Men)
- c. 25m Pistol (30 + 30 shots) (Women)
- d. Mixed Team

During the selection trials, NADA is going to conduct the dope test of all players at the selection venue as per NADA regulations. Further, registration fee of Rs.1000 per athlete is applicable. Lodging and boarding facilities will be provided at the University campus during the selection trials at Rs. 500/- per day/per person. The players must bring their own equipment (Weapons) and ammunition.

The selected players will have to attend a coaching camp, information about which will be conveyed to the respective universities in due course of time. It may also be noted that all SOP regarding safety of athletes issued by the Government of India will be followed during the trials, the trials will be conducted as per rules of ISSF following all FISU and AIU guidelines.

Team In-Charge / Captains should report with all above documents at the Office of Sports, Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies on 26th February 2021 and confirming the entries by e-mail on sarkartalwar_sports@mrii.edu.in on or before 22nd Feb 2021. The players are advised to reach the Manav Rachna Campus, about 12:00 noon onwards on the 26th of February. The FISU General Regulations for Participation (Annexure-I) & Sports Specific Eligibility (Annexure-II) criteria prescribed by the organizing committee for participating in the selection trials is attached here, along with SOP guidelines from Govt. of India. Any other information regarding the trials, will be uploaded on our website www.manavrachna.edu.in

Note: As per the MHA/ Haryana Government guidelines, all athletes have to undergo the RT- PCR test (Compulsory) at their own cost and submit the reports at the venue. Only those Participants with a 'negative test result' will be allowed for the selection trials.

Annexure-I

**GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION OF INDIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
TEAMS/ATHLETES**

FISU GENERAL REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

I. General Eligibility

1. The athletes:

- A. be a national of the country they represent;
- B. born between 1 January 1996 and 31 December 2003;
- C. students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the university or similar institute, the status of which is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country;
- D. Former students of the institutions mentioned in 'c) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the calendar year preceding the event.*

II. General Guidelines for Selection of Indian Universities National Team/Athlete

- 2.1. Merit will be based on Individual score and not the team score for individual events.
- 2.2. The decision of the selection committee will be final and binding.
- 2.3. Participation in WUG 2021: The other expenditure i.e. travel expenses, registration fee, incidental charges, playing kit, ceremonial dress, local transport, visa fee, accommodation charges, participation fee etc., will be borne by the concerned universities.

*Due to Covid-19 Pandemic

2.4. Selection Trials:

- A. Registration Fee: of Rs.1000 per athlete.

B. Boarding and Lodging: For boarding and lodging Rs. 500/- per head-per day from athletes & officials (concerned University) may be charged by the host/organizing university.

C. By taking into consideration the prevailing pandemic situation and involvement elite sports persons in Olympics or other recognized international tournaments/national camp/trials etc, the Selection Committee with prior information shared to AIU may consider absentia to an athlete on the basis of his credential at international level. To avail of this exemption, the athlete will submit their application with documentary proof to AIU duly endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor of the concerned university.

D. After the selection trial, a national camp may be allocated by AIU to a member University and the information of the same will be conveyed to the respective universities by host/organizing University in due course of time.

2.5. Camp:

A. During the above said coaching camp the expenditure of boarding and lodging about Rs. 500/- per head-per day from athletes & officials (concerned university) and other expenditure i.e. travel expenses to and fro, camp venue sports specific consumable equipments, if any will be borne by the concerned universities.

B. The national camp if conducted is compulsory for all selected players. The Selection Committee decision in consultation with AIU will be final in this regard.

C. By taking into consideration the prevailing pandemic situation and involvement elite sports persons in Olympics or other recognized international tournaments/national camp/trials etc, the Selection Committee may consider absentia to an athlete on the basis of his credential at international level, with prior information shared to AIU. To avail of this exemption, the athlete will submit his/her application with documentary proof to AIU duly endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor of the concerned university.

Annexure-II

SHOOTING

Sports Specific Eligibility of Players/Teams for participation in Selection Trails of the Indian Universities Shooting Team (Men & Women)

1. Top 8 (eight) athletes (in each category as mentioned in FISU Regulations for the WUG-2021) of All India Inter University Shooting Championship for the session 2019-20.

Or

2. Players who were top 8 (eight) in Senior or Junior National Championship of last 3 (three) years (from 1st July 2017 onward).
Or
3. Top 8 Players in Khelo India Youth Games-2020/School Games may be considered for trials.
Or
4. An international player who has represented India in Senior or Junior categories of last 3 (three) years (from 1st July 2017 onward).
Or
5. Players who have extraordinary international sports credentials or top scores / results at Indian national trials of concerned sports but not covered under above mentioned categories, may also apply for the selection trials to AIU. After duly scrutinizing their performance by the expert committee of AIU, the eligible players will be informed accordingly.
6. It may please be noted that the players of above-mentioned categories for selection trials is to be recommended by the Director Sports/Head of the Sports Department/DSW of concerned Universities.
7. Merit will be based on Individual score and not the team score.
8. The decision of the Selection Committee will be final and binding.
