

New reading facility now open for SUK students

Kolhapur: Vice-chancellor of the Shivaji University, Kolhapur (SUK) D B Shinde on Tuesday inaugurated the reading facility for students at the new library building, adjoined to the current Barrister Balasaheb Khardekar library or the main library.

Namita Khot, University librarian, said, "Only those students who have registered and taken admission to the official courses in the university will be allowed in the new building's reading facility, so as to facilitate the official students."

She added that the reading facility will be open from 10.30 am to 6 pm for students, during which they will have to carry their identity cards. Those yet to be allotted with the I-card can produce their admission receipt for the respective course, she said.

State governor C Vidyasagar Rao on April 24 this year had inaugurated the extended version of the current Barrister Balasaheb Khardekar library. The library has a seating capacity of almost 800 students and has all the basic and advanced facilities such as conference hall, study centres.

Currently, the SUK hosts two libraries in the campus. The main library located near the main administrative building with seating capacity of 500 students and another located near the gents' hostel known as plane building due to its resemblance with the aeroplane. The plane building has seating capacity of 300 students.
