1. As per G.R. No. TEM (3397)/1297 TE-1 dated 11-7-1997 the constitutional reservation should not exceed 50% and hence the necessary adjustment giving reservation to S.B.C. as per GR.
2. 3% seats are reserved for persons with disabilities as per Govt. letter No. Misc. 1003 (510/2003) Est. 1 dated 27.10.2003 (Encl.G.R.)
3. Candidates should Produce the caste certificate at the time of submitting the admission form.
4. The candidates belonging to VJA, NTB, NTC, NTD, OBC and SBC should produce non-creamy layer certificate at the time of admission.
5. S. B. C. candidate should have to submit their Original Cast Certificate before Conservation into S. B. C.
6. If any difficulty arises during the admission process, the Admission committee should take the appropriate decision which should be considered as final decision.
7. While giving hostel admission, please consider the prescribed percentage for reservation.
8. As per circular of Dept. of Education & Employment No. T.C.M. 1204/67/85/dated June 13,1985, 10% reservation shall be available for admission to any faculty in universities in the Maharashtra for the Defense person , Ex-serviceman and their ward.
9. It is requested to kindly provide the following concessions to the Kashmiri migrant students in the matter of their admission in your Department during the academic session 2013-14
 - i) Relaxation in cut off percentage upto 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
 - ii) Increase in intake capacity upto 5% course-wise.
 - iii) Reservation of at least one seat in merit quota in technical/Professional institutions.
 - iv) Waiving off domicile requirements.
