Provide more information about extracurricular activities. Include more field trips and industrial visits. Create a more practical and modern curriculum. Involve students in different activities like internships and workshops. Encourage cooperative learning. Promote a student-oriented education system. Enhance student morale. Provide skill enhancement courses. Conduct frequent tests and skill enhancement activities. Implement test series and mock interviews for placements. Ensure fair evaluation without bias. Involve students in the evaluation process. Encourage a supportive learning environment to foster student engagement and motivation. Provide personalized feedback and support for students. Offer mentorship programs, counseling, and tutoring to help students. Hands-on knowledge by arranging instruments. Implement more interactive and engaging teaching methods. Provide extra-curricular activities to enhance personality development. Offer workshops and guest lectures for practical knowledge. Increase the number of industrial visits. Focus on providing real-life applications and knowledge. Encourage students to engage in extra-curricular activities. Conduct more programming language courses. Improve communication skills and student-teacher interaction. Increase support for external co-curricular activities. Implement unit-wise assessment and continuous evaluation.
