An IQAC Meeting was conducted under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Pro Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Jyoti Jadhav, on 16th January, 2026 from 11.00 AM onwards in the MC hall.

As per the agenda, the minutes of the meeting are as follows:

To commence the proceedings, Prof. (Dr.) S. D. Delekar, Director, IQAC, extended a warm welcome to Prof. (Dr.) Jyoti Jadhav, Hon'ble Pro Vice Chancellor and Chairperson of the meeting; Dr. A. N. Jadhav (Director, BEE); Dr. Smt. S. S. Patil (F&AO); and all esteemed IQAC members present.

Thereafter, in accordance with the agenda, the items were taken up sequentially by Prof. (Dr.) S. D. Delekar for discussion, followed by the formulation of resolutions under each item.

Proceedings:

Item No 1: To confirm the minutes of IQAC meeting held on 26th August, 2025.

Prof. Dr. S.D Delekar read the minutes of meeting as per the agenda which included

- 1 : To confirm the minutes of the last IQAC meeting held on 29th May 2025.
- 2 : To review the status of data entered by various Departments / Teachers in the UIMS portal.
- 3 : To approve IQAC Academic Calendar for the academic year 2025-26.
- 4 : To approve the updated benchmarks for faculty and departments / schools to ensure quality enhancement as per the revised NAAC 2024 framework.
- 5 : To approve and recommend the representative Policies / SoPs / Manuals required for the 5th NAAC Cycle.
- 6 : Any other points with permission of the Chair.

Resolution: The minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 26th August, 2025 were read and confirmed unanimously.

Item No.2: To review and discuss the admission status of academic year 2025-26

Prof. Dr. S. D. Delekar presented the status of admissions of the UG/PG programmes for the academic year 2025–26 and highlighted that enrolment in representative programmes was not filled as per their intake capacities. Hon'ble Pro Vice Chancellor accordingly suggested that the intake capacity of these non-grantable programmes with low admissions to be reduced.

Resolution: It was resolved that individual departments shall make more efforts to fulfill the intake for grantable programmes. In the case of non-grantable programmes with low enrolment relative to the intake in the current academic year, the intake capacity shall be reduced with prior approval of the competent authorities. The revised intake shall be implemented from the subsequent academic year for the concerned programmes. The PG Admission Section shall take necessary steps for its effective implementation.

Item No. 3: To review the feedback report of stakeholders.

Dr. V. S. Khandagle presented the feedback analysis received from various stakeholders for the academic year 2024–25. The feedback comprised: (i) 655 student responses on curriculum and the teaching–learning process, (ii) 200 alumni responses on the curriculum, (iii) 10 employer responses on curriculum and requisite skills, and (iv) 247 faculty responses on the curriculum.

Resolution: It was resolved that the consolidated feedback report be communicated to the concerned departments for necessary action and improvement wherever required. It was further resolved that all departments should make additional efforts to increase the number of feedback responses from all stakeholders in future.

**Item No. 4: To review the activities related to students support and progression 2024-25
(DSD, NSS, Sports Departments)**

Dr. Tanaji Chougule, Director, NSS & DSD, made a presentation outlining the various activities conducted by NSS and DSD. The IQAC members appreciated the commendable efforts undertaken in organizing these activities and acknowledged the achievements and awards received by the students.

Resolution: It was resolved that the committee members appreciated and took note of the efforts made by NSS and DSD.

Item No. 5: To review the AAA Committee Report of the University Departments / Centers/ Chairs & Support Services (2024-25) and Administrative Sections (2020-21 to 2024-25)

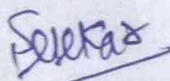

Resolution: It was unanimously resolved that the AAA process was conducted effectively to the satisfaction of all members, and the AAA Committee report was accepted.

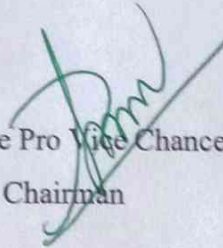
Item No. 6: Any other points with permission of the Chair.

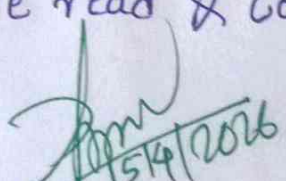
The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Prof. Dr. S. D. Delekar, Director, IQAC.
