Following business was transacted.

Item No. 1 : Confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting held on 21st January, 2022.

RESOLVED that the minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 21st January, 2022 were read and confirmed.

Item No. 2 : To conduct induction programme for newly admitted students for the academic year 2022-23.

RESOLVED that the induction programme for newly admitted students for the academic year 2022-23 be organized by all the Post Graduate University Departments and report to the IQA Cell.

Item No. 3 : New guidelines received from NAAC, Bangalore regarding AQAR 2021-22 and Provisional Accreditation for Colleges (PAC)

RESOLVED that new guidelines received from NAAC, Bangalore regarding AQAR 2021-22 and Provisional Accreditation for Colleges (PAC) has noted by IQAC.

It was further suggested that in view of shortfalls, as follows:

- a. **More no's of MoU's to be signed with Institutes/Industries/etc.**
- b. **Each University Department should sign at least 2-3 such MoU's**
- c. **Each University Department should conduct at least One National event every year & at least One International event in every 2 years.**
- d. **It was further resolved that the BOS prepare a road map for implementation of NEP 2020 in the University.**
- e. **It was also resolved to set up pre-incubation facilities at representative university departments.**
- f. **It was further resolved to initiate and strengthen various schemes of the University to support affiliated Colleges like lead college scheme, Paris Sparsh Yojana, Kalyan Nidhi, Weaker college Scheme, Research initiation/ Strengthening Schemes and to support students like Earn and Learn, Work on Demand and Merit Scholarship.**

Item No. 4 : Report of AVISHKAR 2021-22

Prof. (Dr.) S. B. Mahadik, Co-ordinator, AVISHKAR has given a brief presentation regarding the smooth conduct of AVISHKAR 2021-22 conducted by the University. It was well appreciated by the IQAC Members.

Item No. 5 : Review of activities related to students support and progression and also to establish benchmark guidelines for faculty as well as Department.

1. Prof. (Dr.) R. V. Gurav has presented a brief report of the extension activities for the year 2021-22 conducted by the Director of Students Development and IQAC has appreciated the activities.
2. Dr. P. T. Gaikwad, I/c Director, Sports Department has presented a brief report of the sport activities for the year 2021-22 conducted by the Sports Department and appreciated by the IQAC members.
3. The extension activities organized by NSS Unit during 2021-22 of Shivaji University are also appreciated by IQAC.
4. Prof. Dr. M.S. Deshmukh then presented the benchmark guidelines for Faculty and other stake holders to publish/ edit books for academic and `research endeavors. It was agreed that each faculty will publish two papers and publish or edit two book chapters per year.

In this connection, NAAC, Bangalore has invited all stakeholders of higher education in India (Students, parents, faculty, Academic administrators, educationists, NGOs, employers, funders, and other members of the public) to help the improve the assessment and accreditation in HEI.
