Order

Whereas the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 (Maharashtra Act No.VI of 2017) (here in referred to as "Said Act") has come into force from 1st March, 2017.

And

Whereas as per Section 34(2) of the said Act, faculties of the University are prescribed.

And

Whereas Government of Maharashtra vide its letter bearing No.Sankirna-2017/PRA-LRA-279/VISHI-3 Higher & Technical Education Department dtd. 22nd June, 2017 has clarified merging of Faculties under the Act of 1994 with the Act of 2016 and by the said letter the Government has further mentioned that the Universities should take necessary steps in accordance with the said change.

And

Whereas, the Statute 537 prescribing Board of Studies under the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 is deemed to be repealed and

And

Whereas Board of Studies as mentioned in Section (40)(1) of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 are not prescribed by Statutes and hence Heads of Departments cannot be elected as contemplated by Section (40)(2)(c).

And

Whereas the new Statutes prescribing merging of old faculties with new faculties under Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 is not yet made.

And

Whereas therefore the matter is required to be regulated by the Statutes and in the absence of the same for the time being issuance of the directions by the Vice-Chancellor u/s 12(8) of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 is necessary.

Therefore, I Prof. Dr. Devanand B. Shinde, Vice-Chancellor, Shivaji University, Kolhapur hereby regulate the matter by issuing following directions in exercise of powers conferred on me u/s12(8) of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016.

There shall be following Boards of Studies in the subjects under the respective Faculties.
