A Academic Records (Max. Marks 55)						
The score and weightage for Academic Records of UG, PG, M. Phil. and Ph.D. will be based on the type of Degree Awarding University. If the candidate has been awarded the Degree by the Institutes of National Importance (IITs, NITs, IISER, IIM etc) or Foreign Universities having Quacquarelli Symonds (QS)/ Times Higher Education (THE) / ARWU of the Shanghai World University Rankings within 200, then highest marks shall be given. In case of Central/State Public Universities (including State/ Central Deemed to be Universities) or equivalent holding NIRF Rank within 100 or Foreign Universities having QS/ THE/ARWU of the Shanghai World University Rankings between 200-500, the score shall be given as 90% of the Maximum. For other Central/State Public Universities (including State/ Central Deemed to be Universities) or equivalent, the score shall be given 80% of maximum. For rest of the UGC approved Universities, the score to be given will be 60% of the maximum marks.

In case of award of Marks under Research Publications, only Indexed Journal lists of SciFinder, Web of Science and Scopus shall be considered. Score for Research Publications enlisted under SciFinder, Web of Science or Scopus databases shall be 1 per Research Paper for single author Publications. In case of Multiple Authors, the principal author (first author or author for correspondence) shall get 50% Marks and for all other authors, rest of the 50% marks shall be distributed proportionally. No score shall be given to other publications.)			
b)	Books Authored/ IPR generated (Max. 6 Marks)		
i)	Total Number of books and chapters in edited volumes published by Reputed (National/ International) Publisher (with ISBN): 2 marks per authored reference book. 1 Mark per Edited Book/ chapters in edited volume/ Translated Book.		
ii)	IPR (Patents / Copyright/ Trademarks/ Designs etc.) granted/ awarded 2 marks per IPR granted Books Authored+ IPR generated: Max. 6 Marks		
c)	Awards (Max. 3 Marks):		
International/National Level (Awards given by International Organizations/ Government of India/Government of India recognized National Level Bodies): 03 State Level (Awards given by State Government): 02 International/National/ State Level Awards: Max. 3 Marks Thus the overall weightage of Academic, Teaching and Research Credentials for the position of Assistant Professor (through 3- A to C) shall be 75%.
