Committee 1: Finance and Infrastructure	Smooth purchase process, prompt utilization certificates of all projects; maintenance and keeping record of all buildings and infrastructures related to Research and Development in the campus.
Committee 2 : Research Programme, Policy Development:	To keep a track of research programs including research incentives at Shivaji University and assists in developing single window research policy of Shivaji University
Committee 3: Collaborations and Community :	Build on sustainable intra, inter Departmental, Institutional,, Governmental, Industrial (regional), NGO's through multidisciplinary, transdisciplinary research, innovation collaborations for a consistent quality research and enhanced productivity for a strategic partnership. Identification of in-house experts in Shivaji University Departments to create research-centric groups of human capitals.
Committee 4: Product Development, Monitoring and Commercialization :	Formulate Rules and Regulations for early identification of ideas, direct to expert groups, incubate leading to potential commercialization along with the support.
Committee 5: IPR, Legal and Ethical Matters :	Formulate IPR Rules and Regulations to promote filing of patents/disclosures which are legally bound with respect to multidepartmental/multiinstitutional joint patents. Formulate Rules and Regulations through ethical committees for life sciences/medical related researcher with NABL certification. Formulate Rules and Regulations through research ethical committee for publications, thesis etc. (centralize plagiarism check of articles, thesis).
