# Varsity to announce final merit list on June 17

Kolhapur: The Shivaji University, Kolhapur (SUK) is all set to announce the final merit list of students who have qualified in the entrance examination on June 17.

The admission process will begin from June 20.

According to the admission schedule, the seats will be announced on June 20 and the admission round will start from June 21. The admission process is reserved for the chemistry students on June 22.

A recent SUK circular read, "The vacant seats from the first round will be filled in the second round. The number of vacant seats will be announced on June 27 and the second round will start from June 28 respectively."

The other university quota seats and the spot admissions will be announced on June 29 along with the admission details, the circular added.

According to the SUK circular, the entrance exam details have been made available at the SUK website. A separate admission 2017 link too has been provided on the official website to help students gather more information about the course details.

It has to be noted that SUK has 40 different departmental courses that conducts entrance examination for over 25 post-graduation courses every year.

Other courses such as social sciences, languages and political sciences do not require an entrance exam.
