# Apply for degree certificates online

**Kolhapur:** Students can start applying online from August 26 for their degree certificates to be distributed during the convocation ceremony of the Shivaji University, Kolhapur.

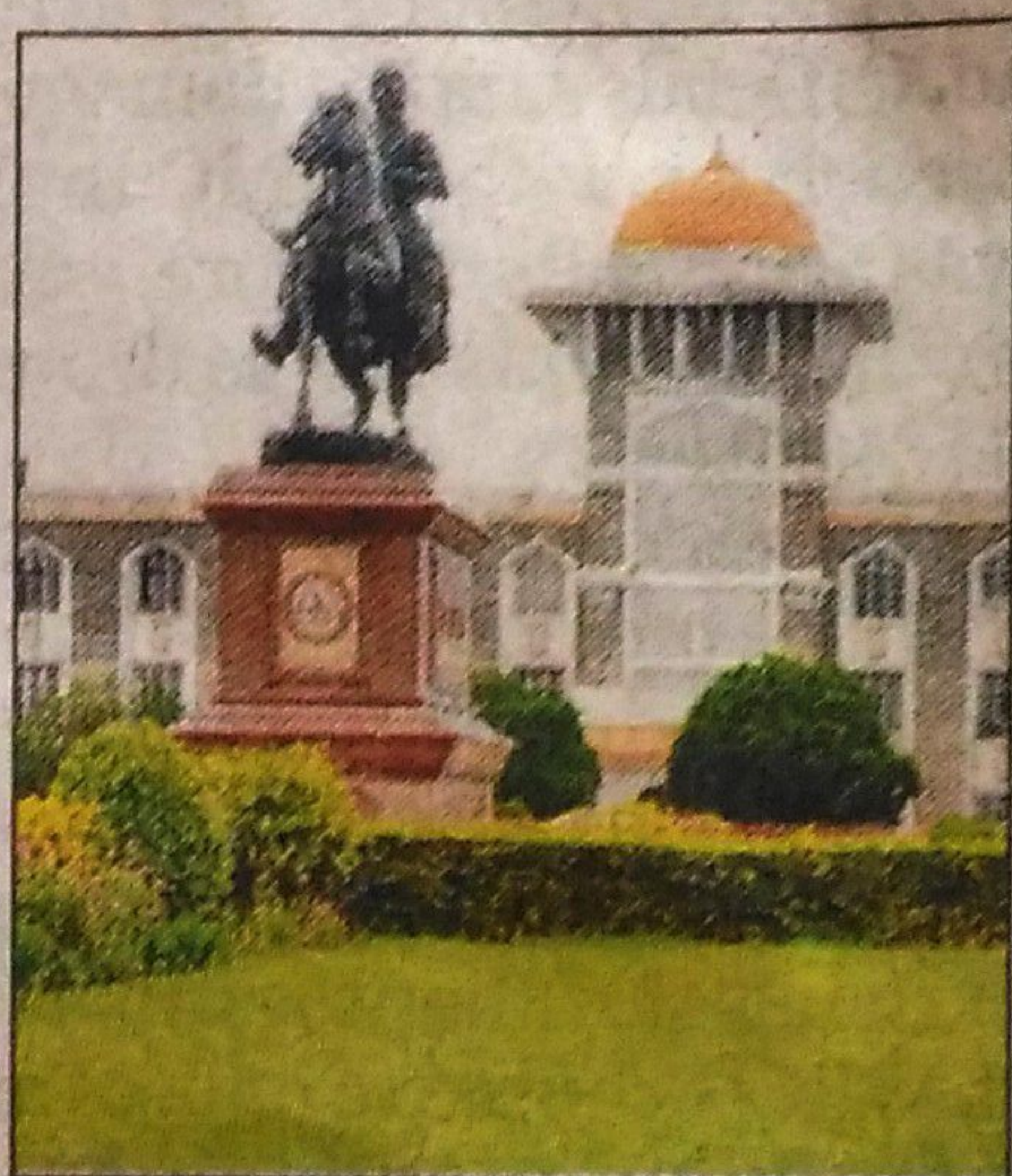
G R Palse, the acting director, board of examinations and evaluation, SUK, has issued a circular stating that the convocation ceremony will be held in December this year or January 2020. Students who

have cleared the exam in October 2018 and April 2019 sessions can apply for the degree certificates, it added.

According to the circular, the online process for convocation forms will be open from August 26 till September 27, with regular fee of Rs 250; while from September 28 to October 19 students will be charged Rs 350, and October 20 to November 8, they will be charged a whopping Rs 850 fee as the super late fee.

It added that for the results, which are announced after viva-voce such as PhD, such students can apply by November 30 with



Rs 850 fee. Notably, the university started the online payment gateway facility for the process in 2016.

The circular stated that the convocation application format is available at the university website [www.unishivaji.ac.in](http://www.unishivaji.ac.in). It added that mentioning the email id and the mobile number of the student, has been made compulsory so as to make the proper communication of the event. Apart from this, students should also make sure to fill in their Aadhaar card details.

According to varsity officials, they are expecting applications from around 35,000 to 45,000 students this year. All the instructions have already been posted online. If the students face any problem, they can contact university officials for assistance.
