1. Abstracts - not more than 200 words and Full Papers – not more than 5000 words
2. All the papers should be in English language only
3. Font – Times New Roman, Font size – 12, Headings – 13 Bold, Space between the lines – 1.5
4. Abstract and full length paper can be submitted through Email in Microsoft Word format to [bacrd@unishivaji.ac.in](mailto:bacrd@unishivaji.ac.in)
5. Submission of full paper is compulsory.
6. The research papers shall be preferably in the standard research format, abstract, spelling out the statement of the problem and need of the study, hypothesis if any, methodology, discussion- findings/ results, implications, conclusion and references.
7. Papers in prescribed format will only be considered for publication. Papers without prescribed format will not be entertained.
8. Organizing committees will shortlist the selected papers for presentation.
9. All the rights regarding publication of the paper will be reserved with organizers.
