About the Conference

Tarktirtha Laxmanshastri Joshi (1901–1994) was a distinguished scholar, philosopher, literary critic, editor, and reformist who left an indelible mark on Indian intellectual and cultural history. Through his scholarship, editorial contributions, and progressive yet deeply rooted views, he bridged classical Indian traditions with the demands of modernity and rational reform. A key figure in interpreting and disseminating Indian knowledge systems, Joshi's contribution spans critical editions of Sanskrit texts, editorial leadership of the Marathi Vishwakosh, philosophical essays, political works, cultural commentary and active participation in social reform movements.

As we revisit his Samagra Vangmay (Complete Works), it becomes crucial to understand how his legacy shapes contemporary discourses in Indology, cultural studies, philosophy, and socio-political thought. Also in reference with the relevance of his ideas to the National Education Policy (NEP) and IKS inclusion in curricula the International Conference aims to contribute in churning intellectual discourse.

About the University

Shivaji University, established in 1962, is named after the founder of the Maratha Empire Chhatrapati Shivaji. It was inaugurated on 18th November, 1962 by Dr. Radhakrishnan, the then President of India, One of the major objectives behind foundation of this University was to cater to the regional needs of southern Maharashtra, The jurisdiction of the University is spread over three districts viz.
