

Rules and Conduct of Against CAP (ACAP) Admission Round for the Academic Year 2026–27

1. The online registration link for the Against CAP (ACAP) Admission Round has been made available on the University website and will also be communicated through the appropriate channels. Candidates interested in participating in the Against CAP Round must complete the online registration on or before 9 September 2026.
2. Before applying for the Against CAP Round, candidates must check the available vacancies for the respective course and category on the official CET Cell portal.
3. The Against CAP Round for First-Year B.Tech. admissions will be conducted on 10 September 2026, while the Direct Second-Year B.Tech. admission round will be conducted on 11 September 2026.
4. The reporting time for both admission rounds is 10:00 a.m. sharp.

5. Only those candidates who are physically present at the venue at the scheduled time will be considered for the admission process.
6. Candidates must carry all original documents, the Admission Letter, and the required photocopies of all relevant documents at the time of admission confirmation.
7. All admissions will be conducted strictly on the basis of inter se merit.
8. The admission process and preparation of the merit list will be carried out strictly in accordance with the rules, regulations, and guidelines issued by the State Common Entrance Test (CET) Cell, Maharashtra State.
9. The merit list and other important updates will be displayed on the official website of Shivaji University, Kolhapur. Candidates are advised to regularly visit the University website for further details and updates.

Candidates are requested to carefully read and follow all the above instructions. Online registration does not guarantee admission. Admission will be granted strictly on the basis of inter se merit, availability of seats, and the applicable rules and regulations of the CET Cell, Maharashtra State.
