Computation of Grade Points, SGPA, CGPA & Letter Grade for Examination having 50% Passing Criterion

10 Point Scale System

➤ Marks obtained in each course (Paper) in each semester are converted to grade points as follows:

- I) If the total marks of passing head are 100 and passing criterion is 50% (50 Marks), then use the following Table 1 for the conversion.

Table 1: Conversion of Marks out of 100 to grade point (Passing: 50)

1	80-100	10	O: Outstanding
2	70-79	9	A+: Excellent
3	60-69	8	A: Very Good

- II) If the total marks of passing head are 250 and passing criterion is 50% (125 marks), then use the following Table 2 for the conversion.

Table 2: Conversion of Marks out of 250 to grade point (Passing: 125)

- III) If the total marks of passing head are 350 and passing criterion is 50% (175 marks), then use the following Table 3 for the conversion.

Table 3: Conversion of Marks out of 350 to grade point (Passing: 175)

- **Computation Of SGPA:**

Based on the grade points earned in each course in each semester, Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) is computed as follows.

The SGPA is the ratio of sum of the product of the number of credits with the grade points scored by a student in all the courses taken by a student in that semester and the sum of the number of credits of all the courses undergone by a student in that semester. The SGPA of the i^{th} semester is denoted by S_i . The formula is given by :

$$SGPA \text{ of semester } i = S_i = \frac{\sum_{j=1}^k c_j \times G_j}{\sum_{j=1}^k c_j}$$

where c_j is the number of credits of j^{th} course, G_j is the grade points earned in the j^{th} course and k be the total number of courses in i^{th} semester.

- **Computation Of CGPA**

Based on the CGPA of each semester, Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is computed as follows.

The CGPA is also calculated in the same manner taking into account all the courses undergone by a student over all the semesters of a programme,

$$CGPA = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^m C_i \times S_i}{\sum_{i=1}^m C_i}$$

where C_i is the total number of credits in i^{th} semester, S_i is the SGPA of i^{th} semester and m is the number of semesters in the programme.

- **Based on CGPA, final letter grade is assigned as per Table 4**

Table 4: Final Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) and Final Letter Grade for programme

Sr. No.	CGPA Range	Grade and	Grade Descriptions
1	9.50-10.00	O	Outstanding
2	8.86-9.49	A+	Excellent
3	7.86-8.85	A	Very Good
4	6.86-7.85	B+	Good
5	6.00-6.85	B	Average
6	0.00-5.99	F	Fail

Remarks:

1. The SGPA and CGPA shall be round off to two decimal points.
2. In case, the letter grade of a candidate (based on CGPA) is smaller than B+, however, the aggregate marks obtained by the candidate are 55% or more, then his/her letter grade shall be considered as B+.
