1. PREAMBLE

The Indian Constitution is the cornerstone of the world's largest democracy, providing the framework for governance and the protection of fundamental rights. It is a living document that has evolved since its adoption in 1950, guiding the country's legal, political, and social systems.

Certificate courses in the Indian Constitution offer a unique opportunity for students, professionals, and enthusiasts to gain a comprehensive understanding of this foundational legal document. This course is designed to provide in-depth knowledge of the Constitution's provisions, its historical context, and its practical applications in contemporary India.

Objectives of the Course

- 1. Learn about the core principles and values enshrined in the Indian Constitution, including justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity.
